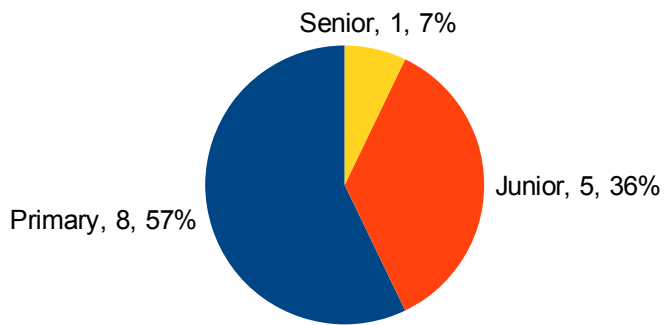


# Bowmore School Council Staff Survey 2015/2016

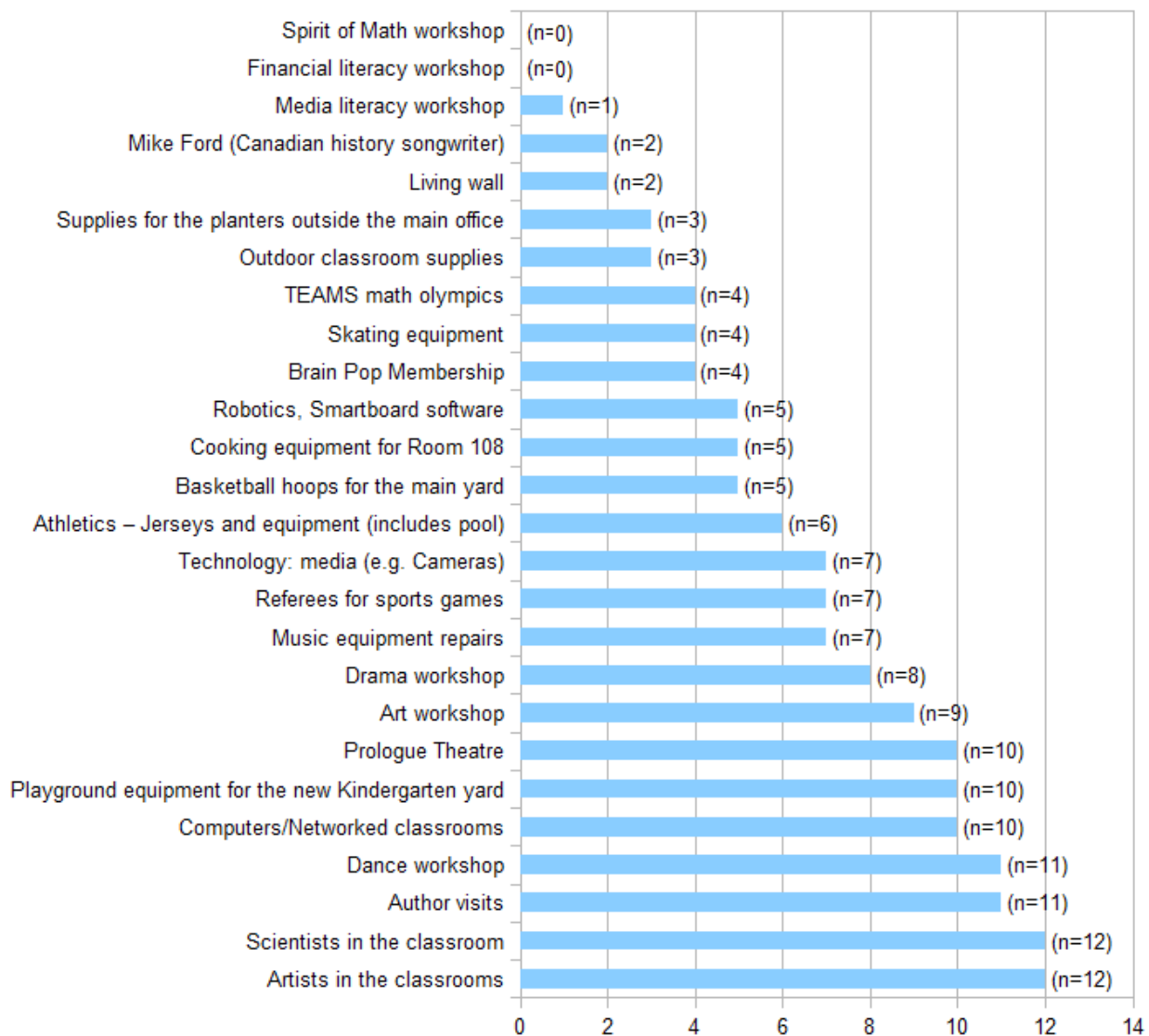
Determine which of the possible programs and resources could be useful in the 2015/2016 school year.
